Thousands of cats will look forward to a healthy, "lying in the sunshine" spring and summer. **BAD NEWS:** **160 unfortunate colonies** can't get altered because they are awaiting a **TRAPPER!!!** Their caretakers are elderly, disabled, lack adequate transportation. **Hundreds of cats can be spared** the infected wounds, malnutrition, and death that accompany kitten season, **if** we can get them from their community to our Big Fix or Quick Fix. They are waiting for **YOU!! Save a life, become a trapper.** **GOOD NEWS:** Trapper Trainings are scheduled for Saturday March 15 at 2:30 and Thursday April 17 at 7 pm. In addition to classroom instruction, you will get to accompany one of our experienced Master Trappers for some on-the-job training before going out on your own. **Call the hotline for more information.** Happy cats! - ❖ **NEW volunteer opportunity on weeknights!** Volunteers needed to feed cats Tuesday through Friday nights at 9:00 pm at SNIP (2445 Crittenden Drive near U. of Louisville), that way our ACA quick fix cats have bellies full of nutritious food prior to their morning release. Volunteers can sign up for the next month's feeding schedule at the Volunteer Update meetings (on the last Tuesday of each month) or can call the hotline for scheduling information.
